Mobile App

How do I read my e-books?

You've got two options:

1 Create a personal account

- You only have to enter the code once.
- Your e-books are always saved on your account and computer.
- You can't lose your books.
- You can do text markups.

2 Read e-books without signing up

- You have to enter the code every time.
- If you lose the code, you have to buy the e-book again.
- You can't do text markups.

We recommend creating a personal account

Open the App Store on your tablet or smartphone. Search for "Edubase Reader". Download the app.

In the app: Tap on the account icon in the top left-hand corner.
In the bar at the very bottom, select "Account".

Enter your email address. You can use your personal or your school address. Set a password.

You can also use your social media login (e.g. Office 365, Facebook) instead.

Make sure to remember your login data.

Select "Product Activation" in the bar at the bottom. Enter your activation code.

Library

This is where all your activated e-books are displayed.

- Click on [i](#) to see information about the book.
- Click on [Load](#) to load the e-book.
- Click on the [cover image](#) to open the e-book.
- Click on the [tag icon](#) to sort your e-books by categories.

Read Mode

Three options to search within the e-books:

- Search within the document you're currently reading.
- Search within all e-books saved on your desktop.
- Search within all e-books available in the library.

Highlight by keeping your finger pressed on the text

- Highlight the text **with color**.
- **Make annotations*** – add a note, image, link or audio message.



* Markups with files attached are called **annotations**.
